
the years before, it will be a meaningful and memorable experience for all who attend.



Movie, Pizza & Jesus Night




Join us on **Tuesday**, **April 8**, **2025** at **6:30 PM**, to watch a wonderful Passion movie and eat some delicious pizza.

Carol (Jasmine) McLennon

Carol McLennon, who we know as "Jas," was born and raised in Saint Mary, Jamaica. After High school, Jas taught at Hillside Primary School. Jas moved to New Mexico with her sister Norma Campbell and attended the University of New Mexico in Albuquerque, where she trained in the Department of Psychology for counseling intervention skills.

After that, both Norma and Jas relocated to New York on December 12, 1978, to be with their sisters. Jas attended the Board of Educational Services in Long Island, where she was certified as a Medical and Dental assistant. She later attended the Borough of Manhattan Community College, achieving an Associate's in Liberal Arts and Science degree.

While working part-time in the home healthcare field, Jas had a renewed heart for music and decided to audition at St. Patrick's Cathedral Church (at the Rockefeller Center) in Manhattan. After a successful audition, joined the choir. She says this was a highlight in her life. She loved singing with the choir and met many celebrities along the way, such as Placido Domingo, Jessye Norman, and Perry Cuomo. She was more than excited to receive an autographed copy of the music the choir did by Perry Cuomo himself.

Another musical adventure and highlight was when Jas was able to attend the 50th Anniversary of the tree lighting at Rockefeller Center with Bob Hope. Every Christmas Eve, the choir would do the Midnight Mass under the direction of John Grady. Another great memorable highlight that made Jas so happy was when her mom was able to watch her at Midnight Mass at St. Patrick Cathedral Church. Her mother knew she was doing something that she loved, and having her there to witness and to have such an experience before her passing, meant so much to Jas.

Jas worked as an administrative assistant at Rusk Institute (NYU) of Langone Medical Center from 1994 until 2014. During her working years, she attended Cornell University and received a certificate in Management. After an injury in 2013, which led to her being on disability, she eventually retired in 2014. After retiring, she moved to Florida to be with her sisters. They had all agreed to move to Florida- to be together after retirement.

Before making the move to Florida, Jas would visit her sisters who had already made the move, and she would visit First Pres with them. So, it was only natural that when she permanently moved, she began attending and became a member soon after. Jas has done many things within the church. She was a member of the Secret Sister in Christ Club, she joined the choir and is still an active participant, she has volunteered with our Big Move and has joined the Bells Choir as well. Recently, she was ordained and installed on our Board of Deacons here at First Pres and, enjoys helping others.

Jas' favorite food is Curry goat with hard-dough bread alongside Mannish Water AKA, Goat soup. Her favorite vacation place was Puerto Vallarta, a city in Mexico.

Jas loves the people here at First Pres. She says she loves the warm feeling and the welcome you get from the people. She feels at home and loves her church family.


CHURCH OFFICIALS & COMMITTEE MEMBERS
