Old Testament Reading
Psalm 47 (New Living Translation)

¹ Come, everyone! Clap your hands! Shout to God with joyful praise!
² For the LORD Most High is awesome. He is the great King of all the earth. ³ He subdues the nations before us, putting our enemies beneath our feet. ⁴ He chose the Promised Land as our inheritance, the proud possession of Jacob's descendants, whom he loves. ⁵ God has ascended with a mighty shout. The LORD has ascended with trumpets blaring.
⁶ Sing praises to God, sing praises; sing praises to our King, sing praises!
⁷ For God is the King over all the earth. Praise him with a psalm. ⁸ God reigns above the nations, sitting on his holy throne. ⁹ The rulers of the world have gathered together with the people of the God of Abraham. For all the kings of the earth belong to God. He is highly honored everywhere.




New Testament Reading Acts 1:1-11 (New Living Translation)

¹In my first book I told you, Theophilus, about everything Jesus began to do and teach ² until the day he was taken up to heaven after giving his chosen apostles further instructions through the Holy Spirit. ³ During the forty days after he suffered and died, he appeared to the apostles from time to time, and he proved to them in many ways that he was actually alive. And he talked to them about the Kingdom of God. ⁴Once when he was eating with them, he commanded them, "Do not leave Jerusalem until the Father sends you the gift he promised, as I told you before. ⁵ John baptized with water, but in just a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit." ⁶ So when the apostles were with Jesus, they kept asking him, "Lord, has the time come for you to free Israel and restore our kingdom?" ⁷ He replied, "The Father alone has the authority to set those dates and times, and they are not for you to know. ⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." ⁹ After saying this, he was taken up into a cloud while they were watching, and they could no longer see him. ¹⁰ As they strained to see him rising into heaven, two white-robed men suddenly stood among them. 11 "Men of Galilee," they said, "why are you standing here staring into heaven? Jesus has been taken from you into heaven, but someday he will return from heaven in the same way you saw him go!"
