Meet our July Pet of the Month.



Patty was born in New Jersey and raised in the Dutch Reformed Church. She married Steve Bevens in 1976. They had two children, Meredith and Trevor. They moved to a small town outside of Princeton, New Jersey. Her husband Steve, worked for AT&T International and traveled extensively before retiring in the year 2000. Patty was a stay-at-home mom who also had part-time jobs to meet the school bus.

Once the kids left for college Patty and Steve sold their house and decided to move to Yardley, Pennsylvania. Not finding any Dutch Reformed churches in the area, they became members of the Newtown Presbyterian Church. Patty worked for Mercedes-Benz as a liaison between 350 dealerships in the U.S. and Germany, with their marketing initiatives. In 2012, Steve was diagnosed with Alzheimer's, and within three years, Patty retired to take care of her husband. They made their move to Florida in 2016 for the climate, as well as opportunities for Steve and to be closer to Patty's sister.

Patty and Steve joined First Presbyterian Church about 7 years ago. They attended services together until the decline of Steve's cognitive abilities became more prevalent. Patty continued to care for her husband as he struggled with Alzheimer's until his passing last year. Patty struggled with the loss of her husband and is grateful for Donna Young, who was

instrumental in getting her back into church. "She never gave up on me, and I am so thankful," Patty said.

Patty is slowly getting involved and has recently became a Deacon. She has also volunteered in the Food Pantry after Sandee Pellerin introduced her to the opportunity. She is making new friends and meeting neighbors, and of course, spoiling her two grandchildren, Kerrianne, who is 10 years of age, and Ben, 13. She is also

a voracious reader and enjoys the downtime to herself.

Patty's favorite food is Italian and her happy place and favorite vacation destination is Boca Grande. She loves the concerts and symphonies as well as discovering new restaurants.

Patty is happy she became a member of First Pres. She says the people are so friendly. She is glad to be part of the family.
